

RV Ceiling Tile Project Checklist

Install lightweight ceiling tiles in your RV, step by step - Talissa Decor

Plan and prep

1 Map every vent, light, and AC unit

Each one needs a clean cut; never tile over them.

2 Check and prep the surface

Clean, scuff, or prime glossy vinyl or laminate so glue grips.

3 Acclimate the tiles inside the RV

Let them adjust to the space for a day before cutting.

4 Order 15 percent extra and a foam-safe adhesive

Covers obstacle cuts and avoids melting the foam.

Install

1 Find the center line and dry-lay

Balances the pattern across a curved ceiling.

2 Template vents and lights

Trace paper templates onto tiles before gluing.

3 Glue in small sections, press straight up

Do not slide; wipe any squeeze-out at the seams.

4 Keep all vents and heat sources clear

Confirm clearances against manufacturer guidance and code.

Finish

1 Check seams and trim edges

Tight joints sell the custom look.

2 Add edge trim or molding

Finishes the wall-to-ceiling transition.
